## USM Grad Highlight: *Spiritual Psychology in the Workplace: A Director of Wisdom*

Prior to applying to USM, I was looking for what was next for myself. I wasn't fulfilled in my career and wanted to contribute more deeply in my work. I felt I could make a bigger difference. I was working for Jack in the Box as their Regional Training Manager when I ran into Eli Davidson '00. She shared how she was feeling so fulfilled and happy with what was going on in her life and how USM's Master's Degree in Spiritual Psychology helped her realize her dreams. I wanted some of what she was experiencing and decided to apply to USM."

Before I began learning the Principles and Practices of Spiritual Psychology at USM, my ego was in everything I did. I tried to force things. I could see that forcing things wasn't effective, yet I didn't know another way. This was how I attempted to get what I wanted, but it made relationships painful and strained.

At USM I learned how to work my process and see where I had unresolved issues. I began to be able to identify where I was judging myself and others, and the ways this kept me separate. USM teaches a critical skill, the skill of Compassionate Self-Forgiveness. This one skill changed the course of my life. The hurts and the judgments I held against others and myself dissipated. I was able to be clearer, more present, and more loving.

My USM education positively impacted every nook and cranny of my life. My professional life transformed in profound ways. I am now in my dream job as the Director of Wisdom at DaVita. DaVita is Italian that means "giving life." It is one of the largest and most admired kidney dialysis companies in the United States. My team, the Wisdom team, supports people in becoming better human beings. We design programs focused on personal and professional development. I facilitate classes for the employees—we are teaching them about owning projections and how to be more authentic.

Personally, I am able to be of service with no agenda. I am more open, which leads me to be more authentic, which then leads me to be trustworthy with others and my Self. I let my parents love me in ways I never would have accepted before. My wife and I have a much deeper, more honest, intimate relationship. I am more able to "choose" the legacy I pass on to my kids instead of running unconscious, habitual patterns onto them. I have more choice in how I respond in my relationships versus being reactionary.
